Games for the 2016 season will begin Saturday, May 14 and run through Saturday, July 16.

Games played on weeknights and Saturdays. Away games take place at Joe Dancer Park (1650 SE Brooks Street, McMinnville). Home games will take place at the Darnell Wright Sports Complex, Jaquith Softball Complex or Newberg High School softball fields.

No player will be cut! All registered players will be placed on a team.

Softball players will not have player evaluations; teams will be formed as much as possible by school.

Late fee of \$15 added after registration closes on April 10. Late registrations will be taken provided roster space is available.

Practices will begin April 11, 2016, at a local Newberg field. Teams will practice twice a week for 1 ½ hours.

Uniform pants, shirt and socks provided by Chehalem Park and Recreation District. Please specify uniform size when registering.

Bats, batting helmets and catching fear provided by Chehalem Park and Recreation District.

Each parent AND player over the age of 12 must sign a concussion waiver when registering. For players under the age of 12, a parent must sign the concussion form. This is an Oregon state law required for all youth sport participants. Concussion waivers are completed when registering.
